WHEREAS, there are some 900 people in Cibecue who would benefit from the rehabilitating of the said building.

BE IT RESOLVED that the sum of \$15,000.00 is hereby appropriated from Revenue Sharing Funds to rehabilitate the Community Building in the following manner:

500 Square feet addition to the building
New septic and leach lines
Rehabilitate old building and fence

4,000.00
3,500.00

TOTAL \$15,000.00

The foregoing resolution was on September 12, 1973 duly adopted by a vote of 8 for 1 abstained 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
