RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, there is a continual need for additional funds in the Tribal Revolving Credit Program to relend to individual members of the White Mountain Apache Tribe and to Tribal Enterprises, and
- WHEREAS, Modification 11 of Contract No. 14-20-450-3804, between the United States of America and the White Mountain Apache Tribe, expired on September 17, 1973, and
- WHEREAS, Modification 11 of Contract No. 14-20-340-3804, was a loan commitment from the United States of America to the White Mountain Apache Tribe granting priority to loan applications from the Tribe, and
- WHEREAS, the Credit Committee of the White Mountain Apache Tribal Revolving Credit Program, at a meeting held on October 18, 1973, recommended Tribal Council approval of Modification 11 of Contract No. 14-20-450-3804, between the United States of America and the White Mountain Apache Tribe to renew the loan commitment for an additional five years.
- BE IT RESOLVED that the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe recommends renewal, for an additional five years, of the loan commitment Contract No. 14-20-450-3804, which expired on September 17, 1973.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Chairman of the White Mountain Apache Tribe is hereby authorized and directed to sign this res lution and to accept any and all conditions required.

The foregoing resolution was on November 7, 1973 duly adopted by a vote of 10 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
