WHEREAS, the White Mountain Apache Tribal Safety Committee has recommended to the Tribal Council that at least one doctor and his staff should be on duty in the U. S. Public Health Service Hospital, Whiteriver, from 5:00 p.m. to 8:00 a.m., seven days a week, and

WHEREAS, the Council is of the opinion that this recommendation has great merit.

BE IT RESOLVED that the Chairman is hereby directed to request that the U. S. Public Health Service Hospital, Whiteriver, provide one doctor and his staff to be on duty in the hospital from 5:00 p.m. to 8:00 a.m., seven days a week.

The foregoing resolution was on November 8, 1973 duly adopted by a vote of 10 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
