RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, the Arizona State Highway Department is constructing the main street through Whiteriver on the Fort Apache Indian Reservation, and
- WHEREAS, borrow for subgrade is needed by the State to complete said project, and
- WHEREAS, suitable material has been located in the East Fork Area north of Phillip Stago residence, and
- WHEREAS, said roads will be os much benefit to the White Mountain Apache Tribe.
- BE IT RESOLVED that the Arizona State Highway Department is hereby granted permission to remove borrow by contract or otherwise and that royalties be set at a later date.

The foregoing resolution was on December 12, 1973 duly adopted by a vote of 8 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
