RESOLUTION OF THE  
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE  
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the children of Cibecue, on an average, have a poor learning capabilities, and

WHEREAS, the tribe, under Title I, can secure the services of an Education Specialist, and

WHEREAS, in order to secure the said Specialist and Title I Program, the tribe wishes to commit themselves to purchase a mobile home for living quarters.

BE IT RESOLVED by the White Mountain Apache Tribal Council that the Council commits themselves to purchase a mobile home and lease to the Title I Program for living quarters.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that when the mobile home is purchased, that it be installed in the Tribal Trailer Park in Cibecue and the appraised rent value be received.

The foregoing resolution was on January 9, 1974 duly adopted by a vote of 9 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
