RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the Tribe has requested that the Bureau of Indian Affairs construct a new road and bridge to serve the Fort Apache Tribal Sawmill, Route 14, and

WHEREAS, the Tribe wishes to grant a gratuitous Right-of-Way from the intersections of State Highway 73 to the Fort Apache Timber Company Sawmill.

BE IT RESOLVED by the White Mountain Apache Tribal Council that it grants to the Bureau of Indian Affairs a gratuitous Right-of-Way as recorded on map on file in the office of the Superintendent of the Fort Apache Agency, Whiteriver, Arizona, to which reference is hereby made.

The foregoing resolution was on February 13, 1974 duly adopted by a vote of 9 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe, June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
