RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the Farm Co-Op in the past has maintained the Agency Orchard consisting of 7.0 acres of land, located in the Southwest One-Fourth of Section 7, T 5 N, R 23 E, below the Whiteriver Municiple Center, and

WHEREAS, the Agency Orchard has been maintained by the Farm Co-Op for a number of years, and

WHEREAS, it is of the Tribal Council's opinion in as much as the Farm Co-Op needs the revenues from the sale of fruit to continue its worthwhile programs.

BE IT RESOLVED that the land of trees and revenues therefrom are hereby assigned to the Farm Co-Op.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Farm Co-Op be responsible for the proper maintenance of orchard and proper pruning of trees.

The foregoing resolution was on February 13, 1974 duly adopted by a vote of 9 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (h) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 13, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
