

RESOLUTION OF THE  
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE  
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, on January 24, 1974, an election was held to amend Section 3, Article 8, "Election", to provide that any enrolled member of the White Mountain Apache Tribe 18 years of age or older shall have the right to vote, and

WHEREAS, the Election Board certified the vote was 399 for and 104 against, and in which election 30% of the 172 members entitled to vote did cast their ballot, and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council approved such certified by the Board.

BE IT RESOLVED that the certified results of election to amend Section 3, Article 8, it is hereby approved and confirmed.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Chairman is entitled to sign any documents necessary to effectuate the amendment of the Tribal Constitution to provide for the voting of 18 year olds.

The foregoing resolution was on February 13, 1974 duly adopted by a vote of 9 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article X of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
