RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, United States Public Health Service is working on Project No. 73-219; and

WHEREAS, Public Health Service desires that the White Mountain Apache Utility Authority to construct the water lines, septic tanks and drainfields; and

WHEREAS, the Council is in agreement that the Utility Authority can enter into an agreement with the Public Health Service.

BE IT RESOLVED by the White Mountain Apache Tribal Council that the Utility Authority entered into an agreement with the Indian Health Service for the completion of Project No. 73-219

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Chairman is authorized and directed to sign all required documents consummating this agreement.

The foregoing resolution was on February 13, 1974, duly adopted by a vote of 9 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (j) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
