

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the Memorandum of Agreement between the Indian Health Service and White Mountain Apache Tribe dated January, 1973, has been amended, and

WHEREAS, this Amendment was to extend water and sewer mains to provide the sewer service for the existing homes in Whiteriver, and

WHEREAS, the Indian Health Service wishes to amend the Memorandum of Agreement again, and

WHEREAS, a total of 1,200 manpower hours be changed to a total of 11,200, and

WHEREAS, the allowance of \$6,500 be changed to a total of \$41,500.

BE IT RESOLVED by the White Mountain Apache Tribal Council that the Memorandum of Agreement be modified to reflect the above totals.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Chairman be authorized and directed to sign any or all documents requested for this modification.

The foregoing resolution was on February 13, 1974 duly adopted by a vote of 9 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (j) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe, June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
