WHEREAS, the White Mountain Apache Tribe has successfully negotiated contracts to carry out some Bureau of Indian Affairs functions, and

WHEREAS, it appears that the Employment Assistance function maybe one which the Tribe can administer, and

WHEREAS, the White Mountain Apache Tribal Council has expressed a desire to pursue this possibility further.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that the Tribal Chairman be authorized to negotiate, and if negotiations are successful sign all necessary documents and enter into Employment Assistance services contract with the Bureau of Indian Affairs.

BE IT FORTHER RESOLVED that the Tribal Council desires to have negotiations held at the Fort Apache Agency if at all possible.

The foregoing resolution was on February 13, 1974 duly adopted by a vote of 9 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (b) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
