WHEREAS, a Seven-Mile Church has requested permission to construct on the permit, and

WHEREAS, the said construction is to be used as an Arts and Crafts Center, and

WHEREAS, the source of funding and the construction will be taken care of by the Seven-Mile Church.

BE IT RESOLVED by the White Mountain Apache Tribal Council that permission is granted for the Seven-Mile Church to construct the said building and to be utilized as the Arts and Craft Center.

The foregoing resolution was on February 14, 1974 duly adopted by a vote of 9 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (b) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
