## RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the White Mountain Recreation Enterprise is charged with the responsibility of regulating hunting and fishing by non-members on the Fort Apache Indian Reservation; and

WHEREAS, these predators are on the increase and are doing damage to livestock and game animals; and

WHEREAS, the Recreation Board of Directors and the Tribal Game Warden, recommends that the closed area in 25 W be opened to lion and bear hunting.

BE IT RESCLVED by the White Mountain Apache Tribal Council that this recommendation, recommended by the Recreation Board of Directors be approved.

The foregoing resolution was on Tabruary 14, 1974 duly adopted by a vote of 9 for and 0 regainst by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (f) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
