RESOLUTION OF THE  
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE  
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, White Mountain Apache Tribal Council Resolution No. 73-178 authorized the White Mountain Recreation Enterprise to apply for a loan from the Revolving Credit Program to relocate and develop 200 new campsites at Horseshoe Lake at a cost of \$171,000.00; and

WHEREAS, the White Mountain Recreation Enterprise will use \$111,000.00 of their funds on deposit in their Individual Indian Money Account; and

WHEREAS, the Enterprise has applied to the White Mountain Apache Revolving Credit Program for a loan of \$60,000.00, repayable over five years; and

WHEREAS, the Credit Committee of the White Mountain Apache Revolving Credit Program recommended approval of this request at their meeting held on January 25, 1974; and

WHEREAS, the White Mountain Apache Revolving Credit Program has sufficient funds on deposit in their Individual Indian Money Account to process this loan; and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council recommends and approves modification of the White Mountain Recreation Enterprise Application and Agreement CF-272, TE-1; and

WHEREAS, the location of the present campground at Horseshoe Lake has seriously polluted the lake and must be relocated or the lake closed.

BE IT RESOLVED that the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe authorize and approve a loan to the White Mountain Recreation Enterprise of \$60,000.00 from the White Mountain Apache Revolving Credit Program for the relocation of the campground at Horseshoe Lake.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Chairman of the Tribal Council is instructed and authorized to sign any and all conditions of loan approval required by the Commissioner or his authorized representative.
