

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the White Mountain Recreation Enterprise and the Whiteriver Police Department desire to enter into a lease agreement for the purchase of two-way radios; and

WHEREAS, the Council is of the belief that there is a need for said radios by the Police Department and that the Tribe will benefit by the proper agreement.

BE IT RESOLVED that the White Mountain Recreation Enterprise lease the following two-way radios to the Whiteriver Police Department:

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the rent of said radios shall be the sum of \$155.00 per month beginning the 15th day of March, 1974.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that after said Whiteriver Police Department continues to make the monthly payments until the sum of \$2,300.00 has been paid, the said Police Department will then own the radios.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that if the Police Department fails to pay the full purchase price of \$2,300.00, the radios shall be returned to the White Mountain Recreation Enterprise and all sums paid by the Police Department shall be as rental for the use of the radios.

The foregoing resolution was on the 14th day of February, 1974 duly adopted by a vote of 9 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
