RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the first cutting extension on the following described logging units expires on December 31, 1973:

<u>UNITS</u>	<u>CONTRACT NUMBER</u>
Turkey Creek	H50C-1420-630
Lame Deer	H50C-1420-6709
Soldier Butte	H50C-1420-6956
Ord Creek	H50C-1420-7046

WHEREAS, all of these logging units are under contract to the Fort Apache Timber Company, a Tribal Enterprise, and

WHEREAS, Fort Apache Timber Company has requested that the contract dates be extended due to extremely wet weather in the spring of 1973, and

WHEREAS, it is in the best interest of the Tribe to extend these sales to allow Fort Apache Timber Company to finish cutting and perform other contract obligations, and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Forestry Committee recommends approval of these extensions,

BE IT RESOLVED that the Tribe consents to extend the cutting expiration date to December 31, 1974, and the expiration date for other sale obligations to December 31, 1975 on the following contracts: Turkey Creek, Lame Deer and Ord Creek; and consent to extend the cutting expiration date to December 31, 1975, and the expiration date for other sale obligations to December 31, 1976, on the Solder Butte Contract.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Tribal Chairman be authorized and directs to sign any and all documents required.
