AS, the White Mountain Apache Tribe has approved a Plan of Operation for the Sunrise Recreation Complex; and

- WHEREAS, the Plan of Operation specifies that one position of seven positions on the Board of Directors serves a term of only one year; and
- WHEREAS, Ida Early has served as a member of the Board on a yearly term;
- WHEREAS, the Sunrise Recreation Complex Enterprise as recorded in its minutes of April 2, 1973 appointed Wesley Bonito as Chairman of the Board and Joe Dora retained as Vice-Chairman of the Board.
- BE IT RESOLVED that Ida Early be reappointed for term beginning February 14, 1974, ending February 14, 1975.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that Wesley Bonito be reappointed Chairman of the Sunrise Board for a term of five years, beginning February 14, 1974, ending February 14, 1979.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Tribal Council feels that Joe Dora is also qualified to serve as Vice-Chairman of the Board for the remaining term.

The foregoing resolution was on February 14, 1974 duly adopted by a vote of 9 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i), (s) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. Stat. 984).
