RESOLUTION OF THE  
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE  
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the land using Tribal enterprises have long needed good maps to facilitate planning and field operations, and

WHEREAS, the Forestry Department has arranged whereby the United States Geologic Survey can compile said maps on a cost reimbursable basis, and

WHEREAS, it appears that Four Corners Regional Commission might be able to provide partial financing of the project.

BE IT RESOLVED that the Chairman is directed and authorized to apply to Four Corners or to other appropriate agencies for assistance in funding this worthwhile project.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Chairman is directed to attempt to coordinate voluntary and equitable contribution by the various land using enterprises toward a Tribal participation in this project.

The foregoing resolution was on February 14, 1974 duly adopted by a vote of 9 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (j) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
