

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, an additional briefing was given to the Council on establishment of a new industry in cinders, sand, gravel, and other construction materials, in accordance with Resolution No. 73-193; and

WHEREAS, it was recommended that the industry be established and operated by an outside firm and that draft Solicitation for Proposals, environmental assessment, and Plan of Operations be simultaneously prepared and presented to the Council at its June 1974 meeting.

BE IT RESOLVED that the Council agrees in principle to the concepts as presented, and instructs that the above mentioned documents be prepared.

The foregoing resolution was on February 14, 1974 duly adopted by a vote of 8 for and 0 against and 1 abstain by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
