

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the White Mountain Recreation Enterprise is in charge of hunting on the Fort Apache Indian Reservation, and

WHEREAS, the White Mountain Recreation Board of Directors and the Tribal Game Wardens recommends that an early guided bull only elk season be set as of September 27, 1974 through October 3, 1974 for 10 permits, also October 8, 1974 through October 14, 1974 for 10 permits. The fee will be \$750.00 for each permit, a total of 20 bull only permits to be issued, and

WHEREAS, the late elk season be set on the same dates as the Arizona Game Department with two hundred (200) bull only and one hundred fifty (150) any permits, and

WHEREAS, the antelope season be set the same dates as the Arizona Game Department with thirty (30) non-member permits. Twenty permits in 25 E and ten permits in 257.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that the elk and antelope seasons and dates, recommended by the Board of Directors of the White Mountain Recreation Enterprise, be adopted.

The foregoing resolution was on March 6, 1974, duly adopted by a vote of 8 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (f) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
