RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the White Mountain Apache Tribe has just completed a project of rehabilitating the Cibecue Community Building, and

WHEREAS, the Council desires that the building be protected, and

WHEREAS, the police need an operating base at Cibecue

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that the police are permitted to use the Community Building as an office.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Police protect the building, install a phone and a desk and be in the office when not patrolling on duty.

The foregoing resolution was on March 6, 1974 duly adopted by a vote of 9 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
