FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

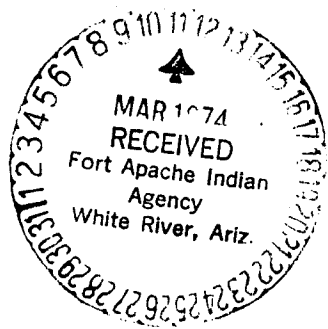
WHEREAS, there was a need to update the Law and Order Code, and  
WHEREAS, the Law and Order Committee, Tribal Judge, Law Professor Canby,  
and certain law students have prepared a revision of the Law and  
Order Code, and  
WHEREAS, the said code has been studied by the Tribal Law and Order  
Committee, Tribal Attorney, and the Tribal Council, and  
WHEREAS, all of said persons are of the opinion that the code as revised  
is a well drafted document and a necessary addition to the Law  
and Order Program of the Fort Apache Indian Reservation.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe  
that the proposed Ordinance attached hereto be posted.

The foregoing resolution was on March 6, 1974 duly adopted by a vote of  
8 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain  
Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i)  
and (q) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by  
the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on  
May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984
