## RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, by Resolution No. 73-108 the Tribal Council requested that four areas be surveyed and staked for a site for a new hospital, and

WHEREAS, engineers for the U.S. Public Health Service selected the site in the vicinity of the old sawmill located north of Whiteriver.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that the Chairman is hereby authorized and directed to enter into a twenty-five year lease, with an option to renew for an additional term of 25 years, with the U.S. Public Health Service, Indian Health Service, covering an area of approximately 67.1 acres, more or less.

The foregoing resolution was on March 6, 1974 duly adopted by a vote of 9 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article 5, Section 1 (1) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958 pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
