RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, the White Mountain Apache Tribal Council finds it necessary to amend Tribal Resolution No. 73-183 to read as follows:
- WHEREAS, the White Mountain Apache Tribe agrees that a new communication system is needed, and
- WHEREAS, the White Mountain Apache Tribe desires to apply for State Block Funds through the Arizona State Justice Agency, and
- WHEREAS, the grant, if successful, is to allow the Tribal Police Department to upgrade the Police Department's Communication systems through the purchase of modern communications equipment, and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council has agreed to contribute installation cost of these equipment.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that the Chairman be given authority to negotiate and sign all necessary documents to consumate this contract with the Arizona Justice Planning Agency of Arizona.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that this contract go into effect when the necessary contract is awarded if and so the grant is approved.

The foregoing resolution was on April 5, 1974 duly adopted by a vote of 8 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (b) and (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
