RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, there is a need for pre-construction Planning at the Sunrise Complex, and

WHEREAS, for the Tribe to utilize the new grant of \$1,600,000.00 for the new ski lift and buildings, aerial photos and soils information must be collected, and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council desires that these Planning items need to be completed.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that the Sunrise Board be directed to include \$10,000.00 in their budget for 1974-75 years to complete the Aerial Survey, Photogrametic mapping and Soils information.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that this work be completed as soon as possible to permit construction this season.

The foregoing resolution was on May 2, 1974 duly adopted by a vote of 6 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (k) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
