Resolution No. 74-78

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the Bureau of Indian Affairs has changed the nomenclature of the Credit Manual from "47 IAM to 10 BIAM", and

WHEREAS, the Declaration of Policies and Plan of Operation for the Tribal Revolving Credit Program refers to "47 IAM, and

WHEREAS, the proper reference now is 10 BIAM, and

WHEREAS, this change requires numerous changes throughout the Plan, and

WHEREAS, minor changes are also required in Sections 15, 16, 17, 24 (c) and 31, and

WHEREAS, the Credit Committee of the White Mountain Apache Tribal Revolving Credit Program has discussed these changes and recommend approval of them by the Tribal Council.

BE IT RESOLVED that after due and careful consideration, revision of the Declaration of Policy and Plan of Operation of the White Mountain Apache Tribal Revolving Credit Program is hereby approved.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Chairman of the White Mountain Apache Tribal Council is hereby authorized and directed to sign the Amendment revising the Declaration of Policy and Plan of Operation of the White Mountain Apache Tribal Revolving Credit Program and to accept any conditions of approval that may be required.

The foregoing resolution was on May 2, 1974 duly adopted by a vote of 9 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (a), (b), (i) and (5) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).

Subject: Resolution No. 74-78

Subject resolution states that the Bureau of Indian Affairs has changed the nomenclature of the Credit Manual from 47 IAM to 10 BIAM. This is not a fact. The Credit Manual has and continues to be 47 BIAM. The only major change in the manual over the past several years has been the addition of supplements. Said supplements are titled 47 BIAM Supplement No. 1 - 2 - 3 etc. The Bureau has not changed the nomenclature of the Credit Manual.

Delegations of Authority are contained in 10 BIAM and this includes Delegations of Authority on credit matters. We are unable to find any correspondence from this office or from the Central office stating that the nomenclature of the Credit Manual was or is to be changed from 47 BIAM to 10 BIAM.

Subject resolution is not subject to review or approval. However; the revisions of the Declaration of Policy and Plan of Operation of the White Mountain Apache Tribal Revolving Credit Program are subject to approval by the Central Office.

We are unable to submit any revisions accompanied by subject resolution. Please refer to Area office memorandums of February 28 and June 7, 1974.
