RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, Mrs. Sandra Perry has requested renewal of her permit near the Whiteriver Airport to operate a Beauty Shop, and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council feels that there is a need for a Beauty Shop in the Whiteriver area.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that the Chairman and the Superintendent are hereby authorized and directed to execute a permit for a period of one year with an option for renewal for an additional period of one year.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the lease rental will be the same rental rate as specified in the permit issued in 1970 until a new appraisal can be conducted by the Branch of Appraisals, Phoenix Area Office.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that if the new appraisal provide for an increase, the increase shall be retroactive to this date.

The foregoing resolution was on May 2, 1974 duly adopted by a vote of 8 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984)
