RESOLUTION OF THE  
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE  
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, Astro Aviation desires to place a trailer at the Airport in order to house its pilots, and

WHEREAS, it is an advantage to the Tribe to have air service available at all times.

BE IT RESOLVED that the Astro Aviation is to be issued a revocable permit to install a trailer including proper waste disposal and other utility connections as needed.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Chairman and the Superintendent are hereby authorized to approve the revocable permit at a rental rate of not less than \$25.00 per month.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that Astro Aviation shall contact U. S. Public Health Service Officials regarding the waste disposal facilities and obtain their approval of construction plans prior to beginning of construction.

The foregoing resolution was on May 2, 1974 duly adopted by a vote of 8 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
