RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, Mrs. Mary Norris requested she be issued a traders permit to operate a cafe in McNary, and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council feels that there is a need for a food dispensing establishment in McNary.

BE IT RESOLVED that the Superintendent is hereby authorized to issue a traders permit to Mrs. Mary Norris for a period of one year.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that prior to issuance of the permit, that all fees be paid by said Mrs. Mary Norris.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that at all times she comply with health and sanitary regulations as prescribed by the U. S. Public Health Service, and if she fails to so maintain the cafe in the manner required by the U. S. Public Health Service, that her permit be cancelled.

The foregoing resolution was on May 2, 1974 duly adopted by a vote of 8 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
