RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the present lease with Charles Patterson covering his construction yard and building will expire in June, 1974, and

WHEREAS, Mr. Patterson desire the lease to be modified by eliminating the 2½% gross payment clause, and

WHEREAS, the tribe desires more time to study the recommendation of Mr. Patterson.

BE IT RESOLVED that the present lease is hereby extended on a month to month basis under the same terms and conditions as the present lease until and if there is an agreement regarding the 2½% gross payment.

The foregoing resolution was on May 2, 1974 duly adopted by a vote of 8 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
