WHEREAS, United States of America, acting through Indian Health Service Department of Health, Education and Welfare, the White Mountain Apache Housing Authority, the White Mountain Apache Tribe and the White Mountain Apache Tribal Utility Authority entered into an agreement, subject to the approval of the Tribal Council for domestic water and waste water facilities for Mutual-Help, Federal Housing Authority and Credit Housing, Canyon Day and Fort Apache Junction Communities, Fort Apache Indian Reservation, and

WHEREAS, there is a need for these services in these respective communities.

BE IT RESOLVED that the above-memorandum of Agreement between the said parties is hereby approved and the Chairman of the Tribal Council is duly authorized and directed to sign said Agreements on behalf of the White Mountain Apache Tribe.

The foregoing resolution was on May 2, 1974 duly adopted by a vote of 8 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
