WHEREAS, the Tribal Council desires that our tribe be represented on the National Tribal Chairmen's Association, and

WHEREAS, Mr. Ronnie Lupe was duly elected Tribal Chairman as of May 1, 1974.

BE IT RESOLVED by the White Mountain Apache Tribe that Mr. Ronnie Lupe be admitted to the National Tribal Chairmen's Association as a full standing member, a representative of the White Mountain Apache Tribe.

The foregoing resolution was on June 5, 1974 duly adopted by a vote of 9 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
