## RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the White Mountain Apache Tribe is in dire need of Comprehensive Planning, and

WHEREAS, it is the desire of the Tribal Administration to plan and utilize, in the best way, community, human resources and natural resources, and

WHEREAS, the White Mountain Apache Tribe requests the amount of \$200,000. in assistance to establish a Tribal Planning Office and Staff, and

WHEREAS, it is the Tribe's feeling that we have the capabilities to formulate the Comprehensive Plan to our satisfaction by using the local Agency Staff as resource people, and

WHEREAS, with the local planning office action, we can fulfill our need of planning communities for better living areas, for economic development of compatible industries to improve our great figure of unemployment of approximately 45%.

BE IT RESOLVED by the White Mountain Apache Tribe, if assistance is received, we will immediately organize and implement a Planning Staff and Program.

The foregoing resolution was on June 5, 1974 duly adopted by a vote of 8 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
