RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, under Resolution No. 73-133 the White Mountain Apache Tribe agreed to a 50/50 split with the San Carlos Apache Reservation on the settlement of Docket No. 22-D. and
- WHEREAS, at a preliminary planning meeting during the Regular Tribal Council Meeting of June 5 & 6, 1974, the Tribal Council evaluated the recommendations of the Planning Committee, and
- WHEREAS, out of two (2) alternate programs, the Tribal Council selected an eighty percent (80%) per capita distribution and twenty percent (20%) programming.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that their share of Docket No. 22-D will be distributed on the basis of eighty percent (80%) per capita payment and twenty percent (20%) program.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that any administrative cost incurred by the Tribe on the per capita distribution would be withdrawn from the total designated eighty percent (80%).
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that this resolution is to become an integral part of the total plan to be submitted for the settlement of Docket No. 22-D.

The foregoing resolution was on June 6, 1974 duly adopted by a vote of 7 for, 1 against and 1 abstained by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
