

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the Exxon Company has requested a Non-Exclusive Prospecting permit, and

WHEREAS, in the discussions with the representatives of Exxon Company this request will require no digging or disturbing the soil or rock formations, and

WHEREAS, the prospecting operation will consist of aerial operations for radio metric purposes and ground field work on foot for samplings, and

WHEREAS, the tribe considers this a potential to discovery of additional needed resources.

BE IT RESOLVED by the council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that this resolution authorize the prospecting permit (non-exclusive, non-optional) to the EXXon Company to begin August 1, 1974 and ending on January 30, 1975.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Exxon Company pay to the White Mountain Apache Tribe, \$600.00 for the prospecting permit.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Exxon Company post with the Superintendent's Office a bond or adequate security to cover any damages incurred by the Exxon Company operation during the six-month period of not less than \$5000.00.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the area to be prospected be west of Highway 73 and west of Amos Wash Road to the western boundary pursuant to map on file in the Superintendent's Office, Fort Apache Agency and by reference made a part of this resolution.

The foregoing resolution was on July 10, 1974 duly adopted by a vote of 7 for and 3 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
