WHEREAS, the Health, Education and Welfare Committee has recommended that Project Apache conduct a nutrition survey, and

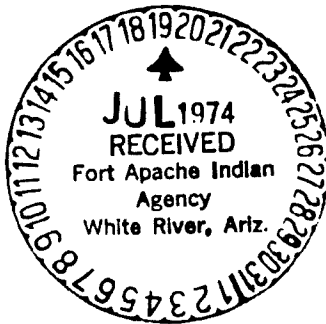
WHEREAS, the comparable index would be the nutrition survey of 1970.

BE IT RESOLVED by the White Mountain Apache Tribal Council that Project Apache is given authority to conduct this nutritional survey.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that they supply to the tribe a maximum of five (5) copies of the findings and conclusion.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the survey start as soon as possible after August 1, 1974 and be conducted as soon as possible or before July 30, 1975.

The foregoing resolution was on July 10, 1974 duly adopted by a vote of 10 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
