## RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, the Cibecue Community has requested assistance from the Tribal Council for community funds, and
- WHEREAS, the council's financial situation is not so that they couldn't contribute funds to the community, and
- WHEREAS, Revenue Sharing Funds are available for the recreational program for individual communities, and
- WHEREAS, the council desires to program \$4,000.00 of Revenue Sharing Funds to complete rodeo grands at Cibecue.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that \$4,000.00 be granted to the Cibecue Community for the completion of the Cibecue rodeo grounds.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Revenue Sharing standards established by the tribe be followed in submitting the final proposal for reimbursement.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the council has agreed to advance the money for the project and reimburse through Revenue Sharing Funds.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the absolute limit on expenditures would not exceed \$5,000.00.

The foregoing resolution was on August 14, 1974 duly adopted by a vote of 10 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
