WHEREAS, there is a need to complete the sale corral at Haystack, and

WHEREAS, the General Livestock Association has asked the Tribe for an initial \$27,000.00 of Revenue Sharing money to complete the Haystack corral.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that the Tribe grant to the General Livestock Association for capital improvement, \$27,000.00 of Revenue Sharing Funds.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that General Livestock Association, in the expenditures of the \$27,000.00, meet and submit to the Tribe all of the requirements established for the expenditures of Revenue Sharing Funds project.

The foregoing resolution was on August 14, 1974 duly adopted by a vote of 10 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
