WHEREAS, there is a need for the Tribal Council to lobby for the new hospital, and


WHEREAS, it was the determination of the council that a delegation go to Washington, D. C. as soon as possible, and


WHEREAS, the Chairman of the Tribal Council is to select the delegation for the HEW Committee and the Tribal Council.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that the Chairman is hereby authorized to select the delegation to make the appropriate arrangements and to establish the itineraries for the delegation at a time of his choice.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that expenditures for this trip are to be taken from council expenditures that have been programmed and expenditures from the Health, Education and Welfare that have been programmed. Any additional funds required should be withdrawn from the Tribal Contingency Funds.

The foregoing resolution was on August 14, 1974 duly adopted by a vote of 9 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) and (k) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).

SUBJECT: Tribal Resolution No. 74-121

Resolution No. 74-121 authorizes the Tribal Chairman to select a delegation from the HEW Committee and the Tribal Council to make a trip to Washington, D.C. to contact the appropriate Congressional leaders and the appropriate people in the Department of Health, Education and Welfare to accelerate if possible the appropriation of funds and the construction of the new installation in the Whiteriver area.
