FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION


WHEREAS, the Indian Health Service request a change in the Public Law 86-121 Priority Listing, and


WHEREAS, after consideration by the Tribal Council, it was agreed that the proposed priority was more satisfactory to the council.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that the new priority listing for Public Law 86-121 projects for the reservation be:

1. Alchesay Flat
2. Cibecue
3. McNary
4. Forestdale

The foregoing resolution was on August 15, 1974 duly adopted by a vote of 10 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).

By making this adjustment, Alchessy Flat was put in number one priority above Cibecus, due to funds for Cibecus which will become available through some other source and the project would possibly start before the Alchessy Flat project.
