## RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the Whiteriver School District No. 20 has requested additional lands for the construction of a new high school, and

WHEREAS, the lands requested are not properly in use and thirteen (13) acres is presently south of present base all field and the remaining acreage of fifty (50) acres is south across the read.

E IT RESCLVED by the council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that tentative approval is given for the assignment of said lands and with the final approval being contingent upon the assignment survey and location.

The foregoing resolution was on September 12, 1974 duly adopted by a vote of 9 for and 0 against by the tribal council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (1) of the Amended Constitution and y-Laws f the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 1 of the Act f June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
