

## RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, the U. S. Public Health Service presented to the council,
  Memorandum of Agreement for Seven Mile Community, Fort Apache
  Indian Reservation, and
- WHEREAS, after a lengthy discussion, the council also decided that a new field worker be assigned to the project.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that the Memorandum of Agreement between United States of America and White Mountain Apache Tribe and the White Mountain Apache Utility Authority for domestic and sewage disposal facilities for the Seven Mile Community, Fort Apache Indian Reservation is hereby accepted.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Chairman be given the authority to sign any and all required documents consummating the agreement.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that Resolution No. 74-132 is hereby rescinded.

The foregoing resolution was on September 26, 1974 duly adopted by a vote of 9 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V. Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
