



RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the White Mountain Apache Tribe has requested assistance from the U.S. Public Health Service for the development of sanitary water and sewage facilities, and

WHEREAS, under Public Law 86-121, the White Mountain Apache Tribe that the Memorandum of Agreement between United States of America and the White Mountain Apache Tribe and the White Mountain Apache Utility Authority for domestic water supply, sewage disposal facilities for the Fort Apache Indian Reservation for the forty (40) units be accepted.

The foregoing resolution was on September 26, 1974 duly adopted by a vote of 9 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
