FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the tribe has received an offer of a grant for a mapping project from the Four Corners Regional Commission, pursuant to and compatible with our application dated March 4, 1974 and Resolution No. 74-37, and

WHEREAS, it is and has been the intention that the U. S. Geological Survey would compile the maps.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that the Tribal Chairman is authorized to accept said grant offer, to enter into an agreement with the U. S. Geological Survey for the compilation of these maps, and to sign any and all documents necessary to consummate this project.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that Kenneth Dupuis is named as the Project Director and Raymus Albert as a member of the Review Committee, as outlined in the grant offer.

The foregoing resolution was on September 26, 1974 duly adopted by a vote of 8 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
