- WHEREAS, the Recreation Enterprise has advertised for the filling of the vacant Manager's Position, and
- WHEREAS, the applications have been received and referred to the Tribal Council for final selection.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that Mr. Phillip Stago, Jr. had been selected as Manager for the White Mountain Recreation Enterprise of the White Mountain Apache Tribe.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the contract be signed with Mr. Phillip Stago, Jr. for a six-month probationary period at total term of a three-year contract at a starting salary of \$11,000.00 per annum.

The foregoing resolution was on September 26, 1974 duly adopted by a vote of 9 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (1) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
