- WHEREAS, the Alchesay High School, District No. 20, Whiteriver, Navajo County, Arizona, is now in the process of consummating an application for sufficient funds to construct a new, much-needed High School, and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council has always been of the opinion that the education of its youth is of prime importance to the welfare of the Apache people, and
- WHEREAS, the said High School District needs additional land upon which the new High School is to be constructed.
- BE IT RESOLVED that the Tribe hereby agrees that should the Alchesay High School, District No. 20, succeed in securing sufficient funds to build a High School, that the Tribe shall grant the said School District a 25 year, with a 25 year option gratuitous lease to the said School District covering the parcels of ground described in the photostatic copy of legal description for Alchesay High School, Whiteriver, Navajo County, Arizona, marked Exhibit A and attached hereto and by reference made a part hereof.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Chairman of the White Mountain Apache Tribe is authorized to sign any and all documents for and on behalf of the tribe necessary to consummate the granting of the funds for the construction of the said High School by the U. S. Office of Education, and to further sign any and all documents necessary to consummate a gratuitous lease.


