

RESOLUTION OF THE  
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE  
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the Alchesay High School, District No. 20, Whiteriver, Navajo County, Arizona, is now in the process of consummating an application for sufficient funds to construct a new, much-needed High School, and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council has always been of the opinion that the education of its youth is of prime importance to the welfare of the Apache people, and

WHEREAS, the said High School District needs additional land upon which the new High School is to be constructed.

BE IT RESOLVED that the Tribe hereby agrees that should the Alchesay High School, District No. 20, succeed in securing sufficient funds to build a High School, that the Tribe shall grant the said School District a 25 year, with a 25 year option gratuitous lease to the said School District covering the parcels of ground described in the photostatic copy of legal description for Alchesay High School, Whiteriver, Navajo County, Arizona, marked Exhibit A and attached hereto and by reference made a part hereof.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Chairman of the White Mountain Apache Tribe is authorized to sign any and all documents for and on behalf of the tribe necessary to consummate the granting of the funds for the construction of the said High School by the U. S. Office of Education, and to further sign any and all documents necessary to consummate a gratuitous lease.

The foregoing resolution was on November 6, 1974 duly adopted by a vote of 9 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).

## LEGAL DESCRIPTIONS FOR ALCHESAY HIGH SCHOOL, WHITERIVER, ARIZONA

That part of the West half of Section 13 T5N R22E GRUBBON, Fort Apache Indian Reservation, Navajo County, Ariz described as follows:  
Parcel 1.

From the North quarter corner said Section <sup>13</sup> run S 5°-42'-28"E 1737.35 ft., thence S24°-23'-54"W 1179.34 ft. to the true point of beginning and continuing thence S24°-23'-54"W 357.03 ft., thence S65°-36'-06"E 78.39 ft., thence S50°-30'-30"W along a line parallel to and 100 ft. as measured at right angles from the centerline of Highway 73, 522.66 ft., thence N39°-29'-30"W 214.03 ft., thence 470.23 ft. along a curve to the right, concave to the northeast, having a central angle of 24°-42'-00" and a radius of 1111.82 ft., thence N14°-47'-30"W 228.35 ft. to a cyclone fence, thence N78°-12'-28"E 364.10 ft., thence N23°-50'-30"E 36.60 ft., thence S65°-34'-32"E 583.10 ft. to the true point of beginning containing 11.80 acres.

Parcel 2.

From the North quarter corner said Section <sup>13</sup> run S 5°-42'-28"E 1737.35 ft., thence S24°-23'-54"W 1179.34 ft., thence S65°-36'-06"E 78.39 ft., thence S50°-30'-30"W 522.66 ft. along a line parallel to and 100 ft. as measured at right angles from the centerline of Highway 73, to the true point of beginning and continuing thence S50°-30'-30"W 631.63 ft., thence S47°-33'-30"W 656.07 ft., thence N30°-45'-40"W 1335.40 ft. to a cyclone fence, thence N68°-19'-10"E along the cyclone fence 1280.00 ft., thence N75°-12'-28"E 100.47 ft., thence S14°-47'-30"E 228.35 ft. to a point of curve, thence 505.17 ft. along the curve to the left, concave to the northeast, having a central angle of 24°-42'-00" and a radius of 1171.82 ft., thence S39°-29'-30"E 214.03 ft. to the true point of beginning containing 33.51 acres. Total Parcels 1 and 2 = 45.01 acres.

**SUBJECT: Tribal Resolution No. 74-153**

The Alchesay High School, District No. 20, Whiteriver, Navajo County, Arizona, is now in the process of consummating an application for sufficient funds to construct a new, much-needed High School.

By Resolution No. 74-153, the Tribe agrees that should the Alchesay High School, District No. 20, succeed in securing sufficient funds to build a High School, that the Tribe shall grant the said School District a 25 year, with a 25 year option gratuitous lease to the said School District covering the parcels of ground described in the photostatic copy of legal description for Alchesay High School, Whiteriver, Navajo County, Arizona, marked Exhibit A.

The resolution further authorizes the Tribal Chairman to sign any and all documents for and on behalf of the tribe to consummate the granting of the funds for the construction of the said High School by the U.S. Office of Education and also to consummate a gratuitous lease.

The resolution was adopted on November 6, 1974, by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution. Under this authority the resolution is not subject to review or approval.
