FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION


WHEREAS, the Director of the Alcoholic Recovery Program is in need of a new automobile to be used by him in carrying out the duties of his office, and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council is of the opinion that the Alcoholics Recovery Program has benefitted a great number of Apaches with Alcoholic problems, and


WHEREAS, the Tribal Council feels that the Director needs an automobile to be used solely by the Director and his staff in carrying out the functions of the office.

BE IT RESOLVED that the sum not to exceed \$5,000.00 is hereby appropriated out of the Contingency Funds to purchase a new automobile to be used by the Alcoholic Recovery Program.

The foregoing resolution was on November 6, 1974 duly adopted by a vote of 10 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
