WHEREAS, Victor and Zema (Antonio) Perry have an existing homesite lease in the Canyon Day Community and a home financed by the Farmers Home Administration, and

WHEREAS, Victor and Zema (Antonio) Perry desire to assign their leasehold interest and accrued interest in the home to Earl and Leah (Antonio) Loas, and

WHEREAS, Earl and Leah (Antonio) Loas wish to assume the Farmers Home Administration loan on the property and have been qualified by the Farmers Home Administration for a Rural Housing Loan.

BE IT RESOLVED that any such assignment be approved by the White Mountain Apache Tribal Council and the Superintendent of the Fort Apache Agency.

The foregoing resolution was on November 6, 1974 duly adopted by a vote of 10 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (b) and (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
