- WHEREAS, the position of Safety Coordinator has been established and the position is to be readvertised, and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Safety Committee has recommended that the starting salary be not less than \$7,200.00 per annum and not more than \$9,000.00 per annum, and
- WHEREAS, said funds have not, as yet, been budgeted for the salary, matching funds, etc.
- BE IT RESOLVED that funds not to exceed \$9,000.00 per annum be appropriated from funds on deposit in the U.S. Treasury to defray the cost of this position for the remainder of Fiscal Year, 1974-75.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that reimbursement funds for this position be secured from whatever sources are available.

The foregoing resolution was on November 6, 1974 duly adopted by a vote of g for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
